



Health and Safety Policy Statement

It is the policy of **Anglia Suspended Ceilings Limited** to conduct all its operations in a manner that will ensure the safety, health and welfare of its staff at work and others affected by its undertakings. This policy shall be implemented as far as is reasonably practicable in accordance with the Health and Safety at Work Act and other relevant statutory instruments.

Directors, managers and staff have a duty and responsibility to implement the policy by making arrangements and procedures to safeguard those at work, these shall become part of the policy and be incorporated into the Safety Management System.

All members of staff have a duty to take reasonable care for their own health and safety, the health and safety of other members of staff and that of others who may be affected by their activities. Staff will be encouraged to play their part in the maintenance of safety and must abide by the precepts and procedures established. Information, instruction, training and appropriate supervision will be provided to ensure that this is being achieved at all levels.

Anglia Suspended Ceilings Limited will at all times demonstrate a clear commitment to health and safety, and provide a safe place of work, with safe access and egress arrangements. All necessary financial provisions and resources such as safe plant and equipment, necessary technical facilities, trained personnel and appropriate time to fulfil our obligations will be provided.

Any contractors, or others employed by **Anglia Suspended Ceilings Limited** to perform work or give service, shall be equally bound to maintain health and safety in accordance with this policy.

The effectiveness of the policy will be monitored, and it will be reviewed on a regular basis to ensure that changes in legislation, the Company and operational experience are included and updated.
